## TOKYO SKYTREE®

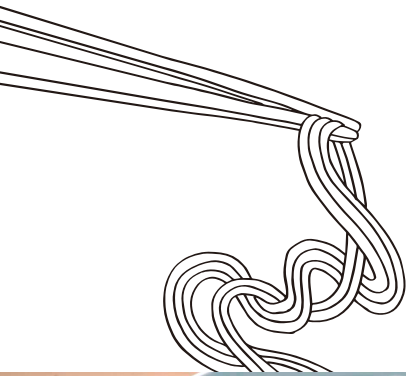
東京スカイツリー®

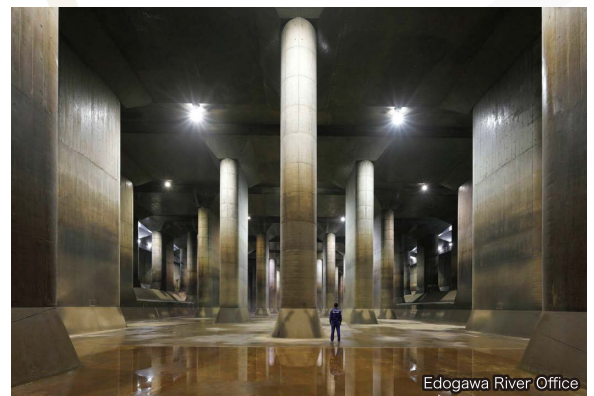

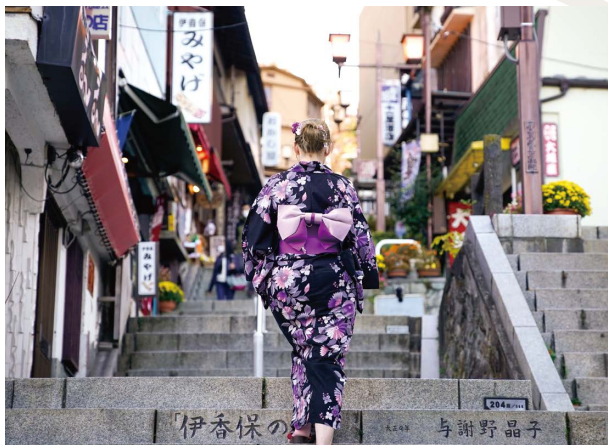

伊香保温泉

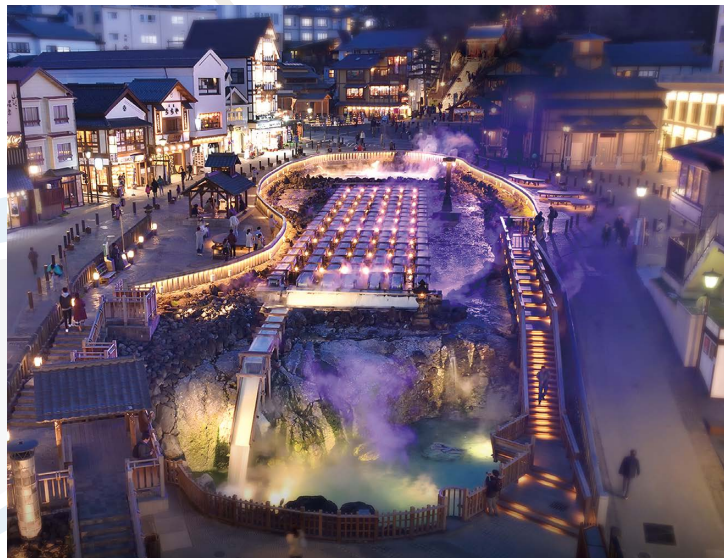

南蛮エビ

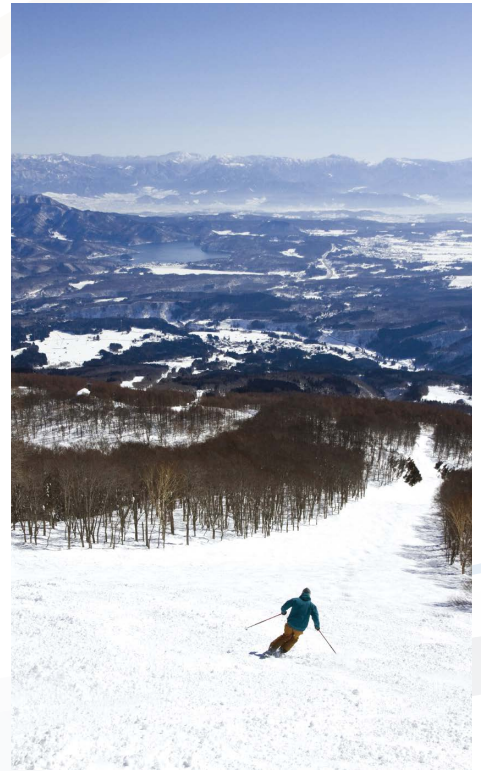

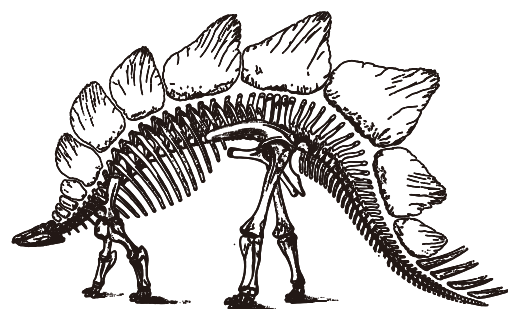
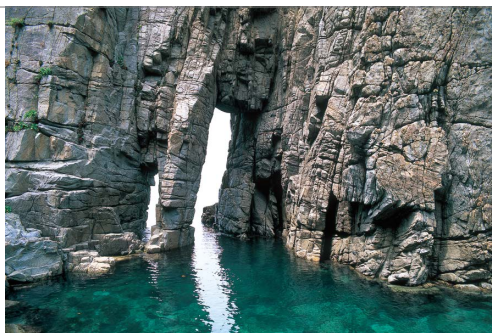

## Kyoto Cuisine 京料理

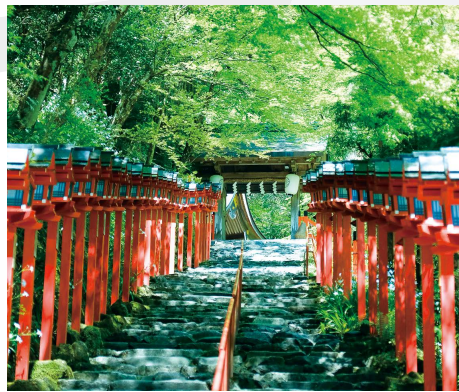

## Takoyaki たこやき

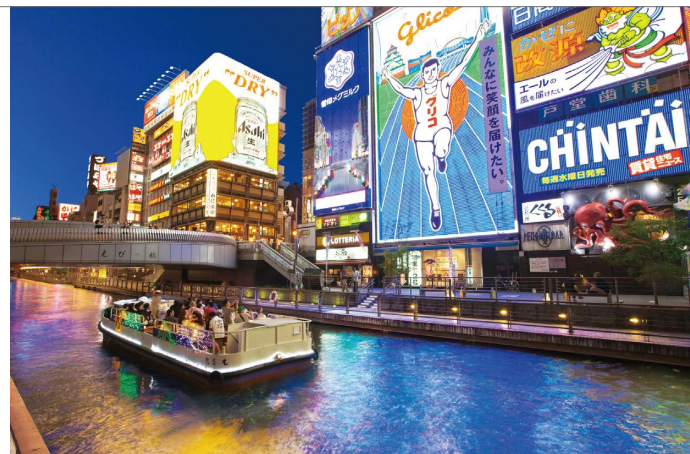
