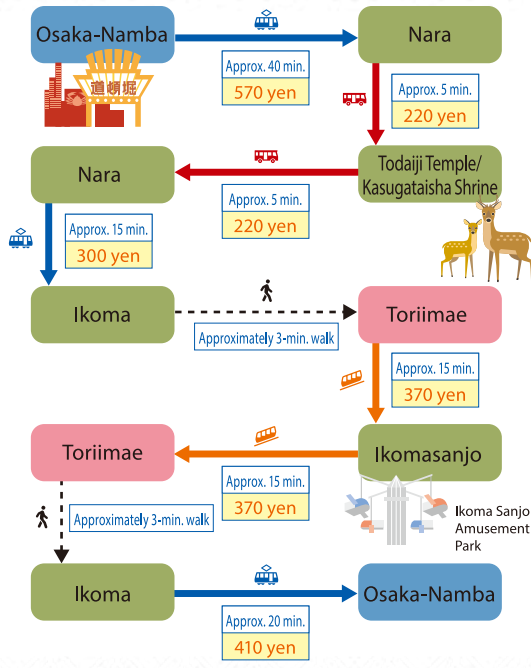


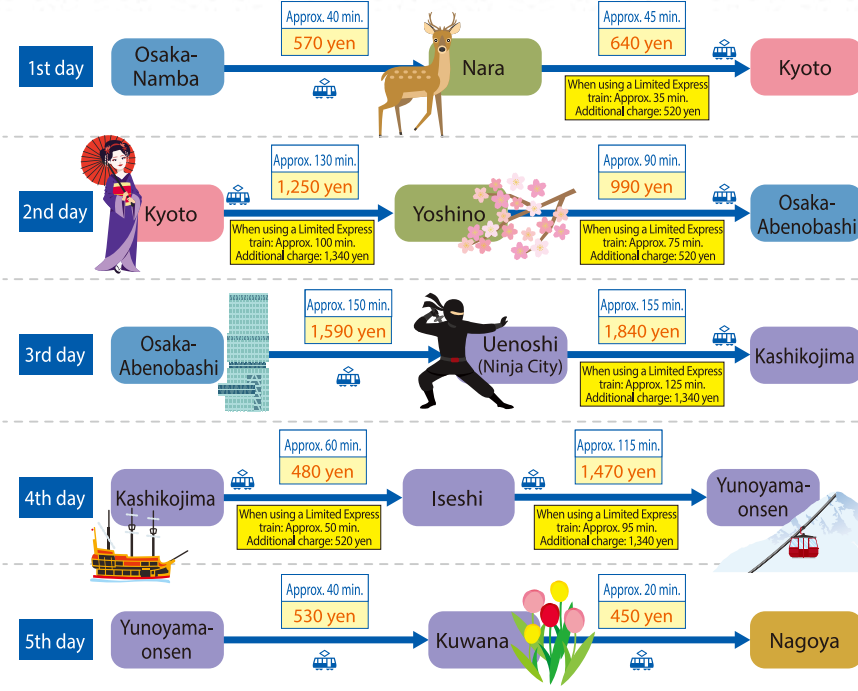

1. Online purchase at the Kintetsu website



2. Purchase at a travel agency or other place where the KINTETSU RAIL PASS is on sale.

3. Purchase in Japan at a major Kintetsu station, Kansai International Airport, Chubu Centrair International Airport, or other authorized location.

Information on the Kintetsu Limited Express

- ✓ All seats are reserved, so seating is guaranteed.
- ✓ Advance purchase of a Limited Express ticket is required.
- ✓ Special in-car facilities are provided, including reclining seats and restrooms, allowing passengers to spend their travel time in greater comfort.

Abeno Harukas

Abeno Harukas is Japan's highest building at 300 meters, home to an observatory, department store, restaurants, and many other attractive facilities.

Nearest station: Osaka-Abenobashi Station

★ HARUKAS 300 (Observatory) Adult admission fee: 1,500 yen → 1,350 yen

★ Kintetsu Department Store: 5% discount on a purchase of 2,000 yen or more (Higashi-Osaka Store, Ikoma Store, Kusatsu Store, Kintetsu Pass'e and Wakayama Store are excluded from this benefit.)

Kasugataisha Shrine

This is a shrine constructed approximately 1,300 years ago. The vermilion-lacquered main building is located in a primeval forest.

Take a bus from Kintetsu-Nara Station.

★ Adult admission fee for Man'yo Botanical Garden (Shin'en): 500 yen → 400 yen

★ General admission fee for Kasugataisha Museum: 500 yen → 400 yen

Gozaisho Ropeway

Taking a ropeway to the top of Mt. Gozaisho, 1,212 meters above sea level, is like actually walking in the air. Visitors can fully enjoy the seasonal beauties of nature.

Take a bus from Yunoyama-onsen Station and transfer to the ropeway.

★ 30% discount on fares (for round trip only)

Ninja Museum of Igayyu

This is a museum where visitors can learn about the mechanisms and traps of ninja houses and the art of the ninja. Ninja goods are also sold here.

10-min. walk from Ueno-shi Sta. on the Iga Tetsudo Line

★ Admission fee, adults: 800 yen → 700 yen, children: 500 yen → 400 yen

Ama Hut Hachiman

You can listen to stories from active woman divers in the ama divers' hut. You can also enjoy hand-grilled seafood. (on request)

Toba Sta. → Pickup bus

★ Discount of 100 yen (cash payment only), not valid with any other discounts

Nabana-no-sato

Visitors can enjoy strolling in this flower and food theme park while viewing plants of each season. Seasonal flower festivals and illuminations in winter are also popular.

Take a Mie Kotsu bus from Kintetsu-Nagashima Station (10-min. ride) and get off at Nabana-no-sato stop (during the illumination period).

Take a Mie Kotsu bus from Kuwana Station (20-min. ride) and get off at Nabana-no-sato stop (during periods other than the illumination period).

★ According to the period, a special discount on the Begonia Garden admission fee with park admission is offered. (No cash coupon is included.)
