

WHILL Autonomous Service

WHILL is an electric self-driving mobility product. Service is available in the international departure area after the departure inspection area in Terminal 1 and Terminal 2.

It can be ridden from its WHILL Station (boarding platform) to departure gates and lounges, allowing you to travel throughout the terminal with ease.

Using WHILL -







There is no need to reserve, and anyone can use WHILL free of charge.

To use WHILL, simply go to the WHILL Station.

* Note that service is not available at certain times. Check for availability prior to use.

Using WHILL



Go to the WHILL Station. sit down on the vehicle, and then specify the destination on the control panel.



WHILL travels automatically to the destination



Once you have arrived, simply get off



The vehicle automatically returns to its WHILL Station

FAQs

Q. I don't have any trouble walking. Can I still use WHILL?

Yes. Anyone can use WHILL.

Q. Can I ride WHILL back to its WHILL Station?

WHILL cannot be ridden while it is automatically returning. WHILL must be ridden from its WHILL Station.

Q. How fast is WHILL?

WHILL travels slightly slower than walking speed, for safety.

Q. What languages are supported?

WHILL supports seven languages: Japanese, English, Chinese (simplified, traditional), Korean, Vietnamese, and Thai.
