## 3 Coral Cafe Bar



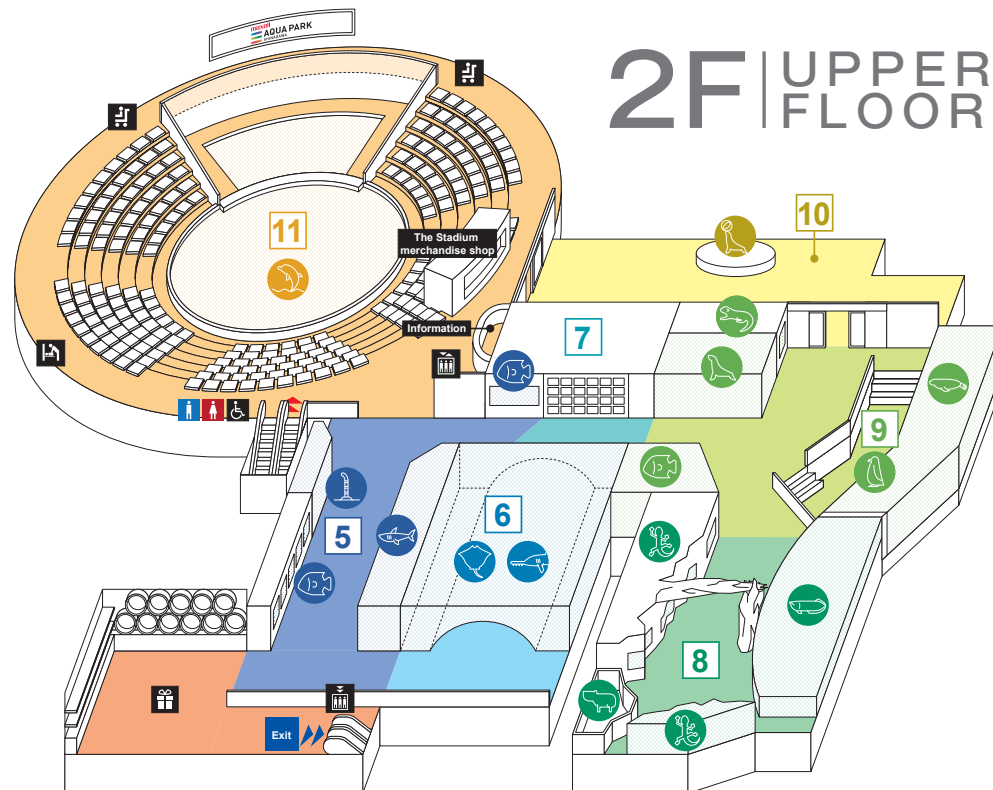
A cafe and bar where you can gaze at fish tanks while enjoying a drink. Seasonal menu also available.

## 4 Jellyfish Ramble

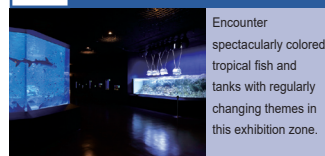


A mystical area featuring floating jellyfish accompanied by different sounds and light for each season.

## 6 Wonder Tube



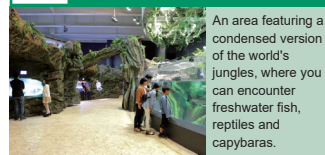
A 20m undersea tunnel where you can see rare sawfish and manta rays swim gracefully.
