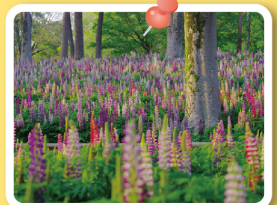

(mid- to late May)



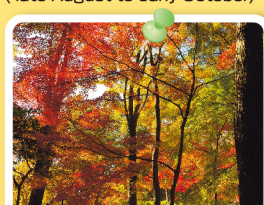
Gold-banded lily (mid- to late July)

(late August to early October)



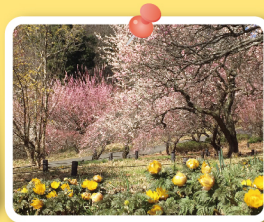
Dahlia

- You may exit and reenter the parking facilities only within the day of your visit at no further charge.
(You must present your receipt.)

- Persons who are certified as having a physical or mental disability or who are undergoing medical treatment for such a condition may enter the park free of charge. (Such persons may be required to present a certification booklet or other documentation.) One person assisting this person may also enter free of charge. (Parking fees are exempt upon presenting a disability certification.)
- To receive the senior citizen discount, please show an I.D. for verification of your age.
- Group discount rates are available to groups consisting of 20 or more visitors, all of whom are of elementary school age or higher, who enter the park all together through the same entrance gate.
- The "annual passport" can be used only by its holder. The annual passport is valid for one year from the date of purchase at parks nationwide operated by the Japanese government.

Available for lending at no charge

Strollers, wheelchairs, carts, canes, reading glasses and umbrellas are available at no charge.
- These items are available at the entrance gate.

Free Wi-Fi

Available at five spots in the park (for details, please visit our Web site).

- To enter the park with a pet, an agreement form must be signed at the entrance gate.

Traffic Guide

By car ➔ The park is 10 minutes from the Kanetsu Expressway's Higashi-matsuyama exit heading towards Kumagaya.

By train

☐ Tobu Line

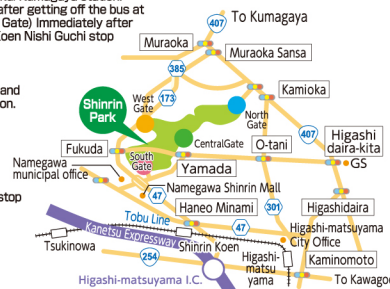
Take the Tobu Tojo Line and get off the train at Shinrin Koen Station (about 56 min. from Ikebukuro on the rapid)

Take a bus bound for Ritsso Daigaku/Kumagaya station: (South Gate) Approx. 5-min. walk after getting off the bus at Namegawa Chugakko stop; (West Gate) Immediately after getting off the bus at the Shinrin Koen Nishi Guchi stop

☐ JR/Chichibu Line

Take the Takasaki or Chichibu Line and get off the train at Kumagaya Station.

Take a bus bound for Shinrin Koen station: Immediately after getting off the bus at the Shinrin Koen Nishi Guchi stop (approx. 30-min. ride) or Shinrin Koen Minami Guchi Iriguchi stop (approx. 35-min. ride)

KIDS RESORT Many play areas popular with children!

Romper Ground 3-minute walk from the West Gate

Wading Pool



Popular splashing pool

There's nothing like playing in the water on a hot summer afternoon! This pool is an oasis where even small children can play and enjoy themselves.

- Children in diapers (waterproof diapers) must wear swimwear covering the diapers.

Area Water Area: 1,600 m²

Water depth 5 to 30 cm

Open season Late April to the middle of September
(Opening times are subject to change due to weather.)

Musashi Kids' Dome



50 colorful pieces of play equipment!

Musashi Kids' Dome is an amusement area for small children. Children can play inside the large dome, with no need to worry about rain.

- Intended ages: Infants to children in the early elementary school years
- On Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, the ball pool is only available for children who have not yet started elementary school.

Adventure Course



Athletics field in the forest

This is an athletics area located in the forest to make the best use of the natural environment. Both children and adults can have a wonderful time playing with the 24 available types of athletic equipment, which include a roller slide and an aerial ropeway.

- Intended ages: Children who are at least in their later elementary school years
- The equipment cannot be used in the rain.

- Smaller children must be supervised by a guardian at all times.

- Please remove your footwear before using the trampoline.
- Restriction of adults' use might apply when crowded.
- The trampoline cannot be used in the rain.

Size Large: 1,000 m²

PARK TRAFFIC

Park Bus (with fares)

The park bus stops at eight locations inside the park, connecting the South, West and Central Gates. One round takes approximately 20 minutes.

ENJOY BBQ

West Gate BBQ Forest MORE No need to bring your items. Just relax and enjoy the barbecue.

The West Field is the barbecue site—a five-minute walk from the West Gate. A plan that allows you to enjoy barbecue without bringing your items and a barbecue equipment rental plan are available.

- Reservation required
- Open season: March through November



ILLUMINATION

Winter Special: Open at Night ~Story of Light and a Forest~

Mainly via the lighted maple leaves that have turned red, the Central Gate area gets illuminated with themes such as Halloween or the starry sky.



- Period: Mid-October through the end of December

Cycling

This cycling road is a 17 km trail surrounded by trees and flowers, and cycling is a great way to get around the grounds. Park your bicycle in the parking areas along the trail and continue on foot at any time.

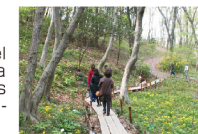
- Children of elementary school age or younger are required to wear helmets.

- Visitors may bring their own bicycles.
- Bicycles with training wheels or training bars are not permitted for safety reasons.
- Please contact us if you plan to use a specially modified bicycle.
- In Saitama Prefecture, bicycle insurance was mandated from April 2018.



Wild Plant Course

Observe around 130 kinds of wildflowers. Feel the breath of nature while you walk along a wonderful 1 km trail. Wildflower conservation is carried out through the cooperation of volunteers.



Marathon and Cross-country Course

Enjoy jogging and forest bathing in a natural environment. Both 5 km and 10 km courses are available, perfect for competitions.



Orienteering

38 controls are located in the park, and visitors can create their own course. Special orienteering events are held regularly.

Dog Run

You can unleash your dog and let it play freely. We encourage pet owners to use this area.

- Please sign a "Pet Agreement" form at the gate to the park.



Environmental learning activities
