Rental bicycles are convenient for taking a stroll and sightseeing!




Also available is the "Iiyama Line Cycle Train Plan," * allowing you to bring your bicycle on board the train.

Shin-etsu Trail


Experience this snowy region's nature and culture by hiking the 110-km long trail connecting villages and mountains along the Nagano-Niigata border.








With thrills and entertainment, it's recommended for families and groups alike.






Nanohana Park

In spring, everything is covered in vibrant yellow as far as the eye can see.








Approximately 500,000 sunflowers bloom in full glory between late July to mid-August.






Naeba-Sanroku Geopark

Echigo Matsudai Rice Terrace


In 2022, the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries certified these terraced rice paddies as "Tsunagu Tanada Heritage."

Kiyotsu Gorge Tunnel


The 750-meter-long tunnel is designed to resemble a submarine isolated from the outside world. A fantastic view of the Kiyotsu Gorge landscape reflected on the water surface awaits at the end.





Matsudai NOHBUTAI Field Museum

Approximately 40 art pieces are scattered along the way between Matsudai NOHBUTAI, which is next to Matsudai Station, and Matsudai Castle, which is on top of a mountain.







About 20 large kamakura huts are lined up on a pure white snow field. It is a winter tradition in the snowy country of liyama. You can enjoy eating hotpot inside an igloo at "Restaurant Kamakura Village" and have fun playing in the snow.






Tsunan Snow Festival & SNOWWAVE



Sakae Village International Etegami Time Capsule Museum

Tokamachi City Museum


This museum exhibits national treasures like flame-type pottery and showcases ancient textile culture as well as the lifestyle in snowy country since the ancient times.

Famous for its grand scale, it is one of Japan's three major fire festivals and designated as an important intangible folk-cultural property of the country.









Nozawa Onsen public baths
